

INFORMATION ON THE PURPOSES OF ART. 13-14 OF THE GDPR (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION) 2016/679

The processing of personal data will be based on the law on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights. According to article 13 of the GDPR 2016/679, therefore, we provide you with the following information:

Personal data (name, surname, telephone number, e-mail address, address of residence, place and date of birth, Fiscal Code, details of the Recognition Document, etc.) will be provided at the time of application for membership of the Federation. The personal data provided will be subject to:

In relation to legal, tax, insurance and statutory obligations:

- of treatment related to the institutional purposes exerted by the Federation;
- treatment aimed at making association life possible in the Federation which, among other things, may involve the dissemination of personal data in social bulletins periodically published and disseminated online;
- of treatment for the collection and payment of registration, insurance and event registration fees for any national affiliation bodies, also deriving from specific agreements with them;
- of treatment aimed at administrative, fiscal and accounting obligations of the Federation itself (including the issue of receipts, the production of telematic certifications, the keeping of the book of the associates etc etc).

In relation to communication needs of the Federation's activities:

- of treatment connected to the need to understand, for the achievement of the common institutional purposes, which are the most suitable activities for the members / associates / users / clients;
- of treatment connected to the need to propose the most suitable activities to the members / associates / users / customers.

Please note that, taking into account the purposes of the treatment as explained above, the provision of data is mandatory and their failure, partial or inaccurate conferment may have, as a consequence, the inability to carry out the activity of the Federation and to fulfill the requirements by the Statute itself.

The treatment will be carried out with manual and / or computerized and telematic tools with organizational and processing logics strictly related to the purposes themselves and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the security, integrity and confidentiality of the data in compliance with organizational and physical measures and logics provided for by the provisions in force.

We inform that the data of the associate and / or legal guardian and the information related to their activities are communicated, with appropriate procedures, to software service providers (such as, for example, TeamArtist / Mailchimp / OVH) also operating at the outside the national territory (even outside the EU).

Personal data are kept for the entire duration of the association and / or mandate relationship and, in the case of revocation and / or other type of termination of the relationship, within the prescribed terms indicated in the art. 2220 of the Italian Civil Code. You can, at any time, exercise the rights:

- access to personal data;
- to obtain the correction or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concern him in cases where this does not conflict with other provisions of law;
- to oppose the treatment;
- to oppose data portability;
- to revoke the consent, where provided in cases where this does not conflict with other provisions of law: the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent granted before the revocation;
- to propose a complaint to the supervisory authority (Privacy Guarantor).
